Join the Friends of the Library for a trip to the American Museum of Natural History on Wednesday, July 18th. Founded in 1869, the AMNH is one of the world's preeminent scientific and cultural institutions. We will meet at the library at 9:00 a.m., board a transit van, and head for the City. The van will drop us off in front of the Museum at Central Park West at 79th Street. You will be free to enter and tour the Museum at your own pace. Admission passes will be provided. The van will pick us up at the drop-off location at 3:00 p.m. We should arrive home by 4:30 p.m. Cost per person, which is \$40 for members of the Friends and \$45.00 for the general public, covers the van, admission, and driver's tip. Lunch is on your own. Due to limited seating, priority for registration will be given to members of Friends. Payment in full is required to reserve a seat. Part of the **Walk 'n' Talk** series, this trip is co-hosted by the Friends and the Library Board of Trustees.
