On Tuesday, May 7th at 1:30 p.m., Bill and Wilma Bogertman will present *In the Footsteps of Lewis & Clark*. From May 1804 to September 1806, Captain Meriwether Lewis and Second Lieutenant William Clark led an expedition across the western portion of the United States to explore the territory newly acquired through the Louisiana Purchase, to find a practical route across the western half of the continent, and to establish an American presence in this territory. In 2018, former North Haledon residents, Bill and Wilma Bogertman, traced the trail of Lewis and Clark. Residents of all communities are invited to join Bill and Wilma as they share their photos and their thoughts about Lewis and Clark's historic expedition.
