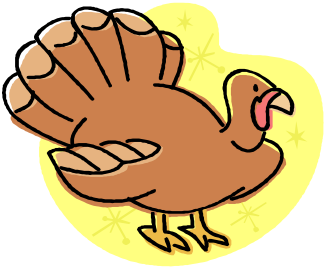


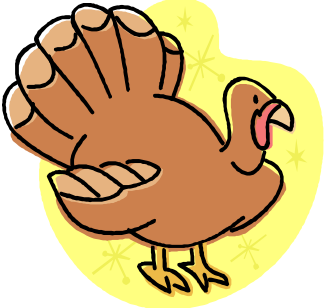

November 2018



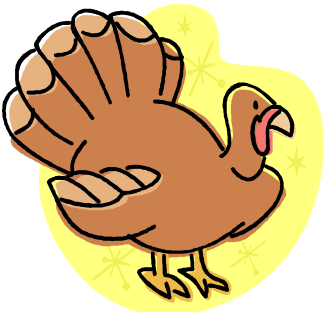
Registration for the following programs for adults is now underway.

The Library will be closed on Monday, November 12<sup>th</sup> in observance of the Veterans Day holiday.

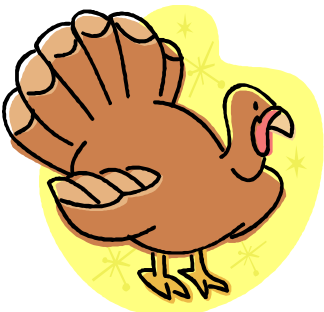

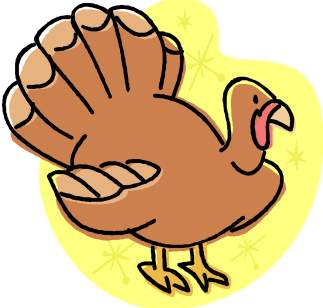
UPCOMING CHILDREN'S PROGRAMS & ACTIVITIES

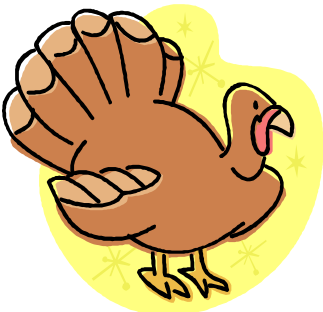


**For Toddlers:**

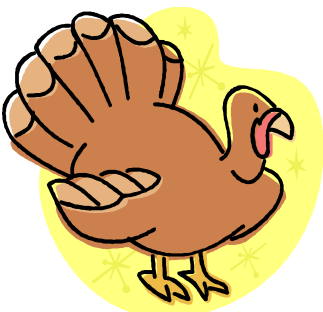
**AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS (3:30 p.m. start-time)**

The **Lego Club** will meet on Wednesday, November 14<sup>th</sup>. Walk-ins are welcome. Pre-registration is not required.

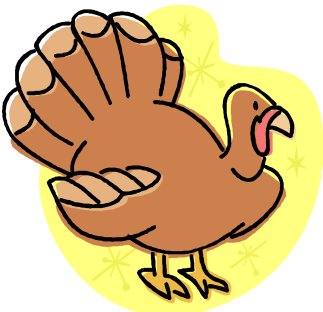
